Upon successful completion of this course, the student will understand the legal environment of business, legal forms of business organization, the Federal antitrust laws, the Consumer Credit Protection Act, agent responsibilities and liabilities, payment methods and processing, negotiable instruments, security interests in personal and real property, other forms of risk mitigation, insolvency and the Bankruptcy Code, and the use of these legal rights and responsibilities to maximize sales and minimize delinquency and bad debts.

The Credit Law class meets one of the qualifying requirements for the Credit Business Fellow (CBF) designation of NACM.
