## Scholarship Application

**Eligibility.** The Scholarship Committee has established the following requirements. Applications which are incomplete will not be accepted. Applicants must disclose any other scholarships they have been awarded within the same year. A member may only be awarded one scholarship from the scholarship fund each calendar year. Scholarship applicants must either be a member of the NACM Commercial Services Foundation or be employed by an NACM Commercial Services member firm.

**Process.** All scholarship applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. Decisions are based on need and contributions to your credit association. In some cases, preferences may be given to first-time attendees or applicants. The Scholarship Chair will notify recipients of awards.

**Conditions for Scholarships.** Any recipient of an NACM Commercial Services scholarship will be expected to submit information about the event or class they completed. Scholarship recipients will be provided with a feedback form upon award.

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**Scholarships are available for local classes, 10-week accreditation classes, certification fees, and regional and national conferences.**
